**Friday Movie: ROMERO** Please join us in the annex on Friday Nov 2nd at 7pm to celebrate the canonization of St. Oscar Romero. We will be showing the movie **ROMERO** starring Raul Julia and Ana Alicia. Oscar Romero, Archbishop of El Salvador, had the courage to live the teaching of Jesus, even though this meant alienating the rich and powerful who oppressed, tortured, murdered, and defrauded the poor of that nation. He stood in the pulpit of the national cathedral and urged soldiers to obey their Lord and disobey commands of oppression. He paid for this, taking a bullet to the heart while consecrating the wine during mass. This movie portrays the story of a quiet, bookish man who stood in the gap between the machine of dehumanizing globalization and the children of Jesus. We see him reprimand all those who would practice violence, whether as military authority, rebels, or institutionalized violence that robs people of their humanity and ability to feed their families.

**Our Caring for Creation** The Social Justice Committee is to be thanked for the presentation (video and speaker) on Caring for Creation on October 14. The video developed by the archdiocesan Task Force on Climate Control can be easily viewed. (it is only 10 minutes) Click onto the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, then click on the Ministries and Offices, then click on Catholic Social Action ministry, and finally click on the Care for Creation video. The video features comments from the Archbishop and actions taken by parishes in the area who have responded to environmental challenges.

### Parish leadership meeting

The St. Bernard Parish Council met on October 23, 2018 and took the following actions:

- Received a report on a proposal from an architectural firm to buy the school building and agreed to entertain the proposal
- Agreed to spend the next six months working on a bilingual Mass and then assess further involvements
- Agreed to continue further contacts with Hispanic families in the area
- Decided to delay work with young adults and emphasize involvement with younger children
- Received a report on contact with parishioners of faith formation plans for the next year
- Accepted a report on activities for the parish's 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary from 2019 thro 2020
- Received a report on changes in parish staffing arrangements
- Reviewed a report on present parish fund raising initiatives
- Adopted a plan to initiate a capital campaign in connection with the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary
- Agreed to pursue a full report about St Bernard participation in the archdiocese One Faith Campaign (after three years)
- Received an update from the Bereavement Committee
