November 8, 2020 The Wise and Foolish Virgins

Matthew 25:1-13

Jesus told his disciples this parable:

"The kingdom of heaven will be like ten virgins

who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom.

Five of them were foolish and five were wise.

The foolish ones, when taking their lamps, brought no oil with them, but the wise brought flasks of oil with their lamps.

Since the bridegroom was long delayed,

they all became drowsy and fell asleep.

At midnight, there was a cry,

'Behold, the bridegroom! Come out to meet him!'

Then all those virgins got up and trimmed their lamps.

The foolish ones said to the wise,

'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.'

But the wise ones replied,

'No, for there may not be enough for us and you.

Go instead to the merchants and buy some for yourselves.'

While they went off to buy it, the bridegroom came

and those who were ready went into the wedding feast with him.

Then the door was locked.

Afterwards the other virgins came and said,

'Lord, Lord, open the door for us!'

But he said in reply, 'Amen, I say to you, I do not know you.'

Therefore, stay awake,

for you know neither the day nor the hour."

What is the difference between Wise and Foolish?

To be Wise - having or showing experience, knowledge, and good judgment.

become alert to or aware of something.

To be Foolish – having or showing a lack of good sense. Poor judgement.

5. When preparing for a camping trip you bring one flashlight and no bug spray.
These examples are for success in regular everyday life. We also must make choices for our life in
Christ. Choices to live as Christ Would want. Read the following statements and decide as to if they are
Wise or Foolish choices for your life in Christ.
1. You decide not to go to mass on Sunday because you just want to sleep in.
2. You decide to help your Elderly neighbor by raking their leaves for free.
3. You decide to not gossip about a girl in your class because you like her.
4. You blame your brother for your failure to do well on your Math Test.
5. You tell the truth that you accidentally broke the window even though no one saw you do it.

This is an image of the type of Oil Lamp that they would have used back in the time of Jesus.

They would pour oil into the hole and then light the wick at the other end.
